**Speaker 1**

Naomi?

**Speaker**

Cooler.

Yeah, I think it will be cooler too. Yasmine, what else do you predict?

**Speaker**

Warm.

**Speaker 1**

Well, let's see, let's watch. Now, I want you to tell me what things are changing in this picture. What things are moving? What things are changing, David?

**Speaker**

The cloud and the sun.

**Speaker 1**

Oh, the clouds are moving, that's right. How did the sun move? What happened with the sun, Christian?

It was spinning around.

**Speaker 1**

Good, that's a great observation. That's fantastic.

That's means it's dark.

Wait, in the morning ... what's happening with the sun in the morning? Is it going up? Is it rising or is it going down?
